

# York and District Road Race League

## CONSTITUTION

1. (a) The name of the League is York and District Road Race League.  
(b) The committee shall be formed of one representative from each of the member clubs.
2. The object of the league is to organise a series of road Races in the York and surrounding area at a low cost and only open to affiliated clubs.
3. The income and Property of the league shall be used for the promotion of the league and also at the league committee's discretion
4. Each member of the league shall pay an annual affiliation fee and have an equal share of the assets and losses (see5).
5. Should a member club decide to withdraw from the league it forfeits its share of the assets.
6. If upon disbanding the league, there remains after debts any assets, these are to be divided equally among the remaining member clubs. All clubs to agree to the disbanding.
7. True accounts shall be kept and at least once a year these must be made available to all member clubs.
8. Every year after the league an annual General Meeting must be called (see9).
9. At the A.G.M. All officials of the league will be elected. Twenty-eight days notice must be given in writing including an agenda.
10. Each club to have only two representatives at the A.G.M. Each member club has one vote.
11. Any alteration to the constitution and the league Race Rules requires a majority in favour of member clubs.
12. The officers of the league to be a chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary.
13. All cheques to carry two signatures .
14. The league to abide by the laws of UK athletics.
